The Great Lakes Institute for Strategic Studies (GLISS) and Partners invite applications for a two weeks' executive training course on Extractives and Sustainable Investments. The course is an annual training whose goal is to build the capacity of policy makers and extractives industry practitioners to design policies and interventions that optimize the benefits of the industry for all stakeholders.

The course is open to government policy makers and practitioners from the private sector, civil society, academia, the media, and international development agencies. Priority will be given to early applicants.

### Eligibility

Intending applicants should possess the following qualifications:

1. Hold a minimum of bachelor's degree from a recognised university;
2. Possess relevant work experience in extractives or related sector and be currently actively involved in the extractives sector;
3. Submit a written statement expressing interest in the training and attach a copy of their Curriculum Vitae.

Young professionals are encouraged to apply.
